

PARC Diagnosis List for GPs & Clinicians

Diagnosis	Optional Criteria
Viral illness/gastroenteritis	- review of hydration - evolution of illness
Bronchiolitis	- early bronchiolitis (D1-2) – review at peak of severity -need for intervention (NG vs O2) – PARC can arrange admission to Cabrini paed's ward if required
Viral induced wheeze/asthma	-first presentation – for education and review of action plan -current exacerbation – review for improvement - frequent presenters – consideration of other therapy
Acute tonsillitis	-review hydration -consideration of antibiotics (send throat swab pls)
Otitis media	-review analgesia -consideration of antibiotics
UTI	-review antibiotics - please arrange urine clean catch MCS -improvement vs need for IV antibiotics -any baby 3-6 months with suspected UTI
Pneumonia	-response to antibiotics – need for admission (IV abx vs O2)
Fever without focus	-for children 3months and older
Acute constipation	-education and aperients (post GP initiation of aperients)
Acute limp (<u>excluding isolated joint pain WITH fever</u>)	-response to trial of simple analgesia -review of symptoms
Febrile convulsion	-first episode – for parent education
Suspected first afebrile seizure	-for review, education, investigation
New cardiac murmur (in an otherwise well child)	-review of clinical murmur
Allergic reaction (not for skin prick testing)	-review post episode for education/parental education + advice
Rashes, birth marks, haemangiomas	-clinical review of birth marks/haemangiomas -review diagnosis (for acute rash/urticaria)

Eczema	-first episode -education -recurrent eczema - review of treatment plan
Infant with poor weight gain (<6 months old)	-initial triage and further referral -review of possible confounding factors
Prolonged jaundice	-persistent jaundice in breastfed babies (>2wks old)
Macrocephaly in otherwise normally developing child	-clinical review
